### GREAT ROYAL MAIL ROBBERY.

Last week in addition to posting the circulars as normal the General Secretary emailed copies to the 34 teams with email addresses and judging by the response this was a great success. 29 teams replied positively and we still await answers from Avenue, Heward and Dean, Norfolk Old Boys, The Lane and Village. Thus we would have robbed the Royal Mail of a total of £ 11.31 had we not posted the circular.

In view of this and the continued strike action it is intended that in future circulars will be emailed to all clubs that have responded. Over a season a saving of over £ 400 in stamps alone. The circulars will also be posted on the website. At present Attitude, Ballers, Boundary, Mardan and The Bull do not have email addresses and we will continue to post circulars in the normal way unless instructed otherwise. Firstly it is an instruction from the League, Secondly it is polite to do so and thirdly it acts as a reminder to the referee that he has a match to officiate. If he has not received his allocation from the Referee Secretary your call will prevent his missing the game and your club being without a referee. Please comply.
